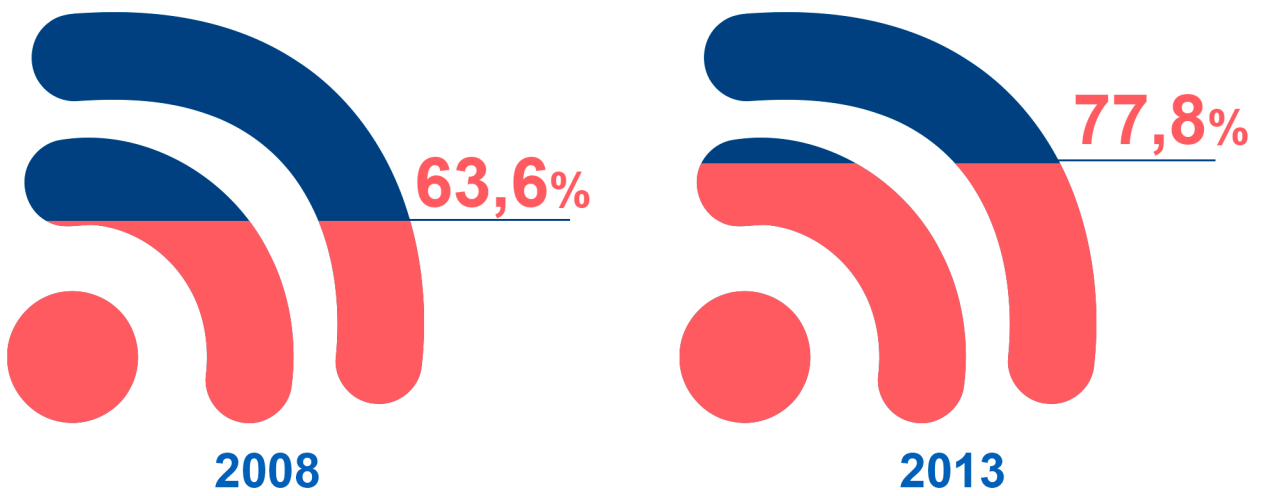


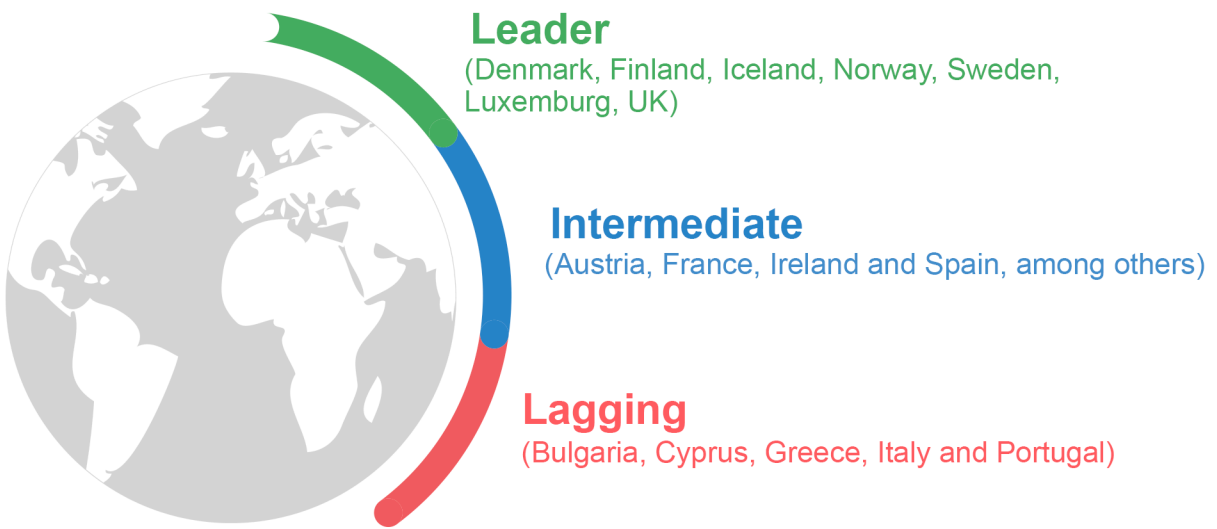
“THE USE OF TIC IN EUROPEAN HOUSEHOLDS: A COMPARATIVE STUDY”

1. The use of the internet (in the past 12 months) in Europe has increased...

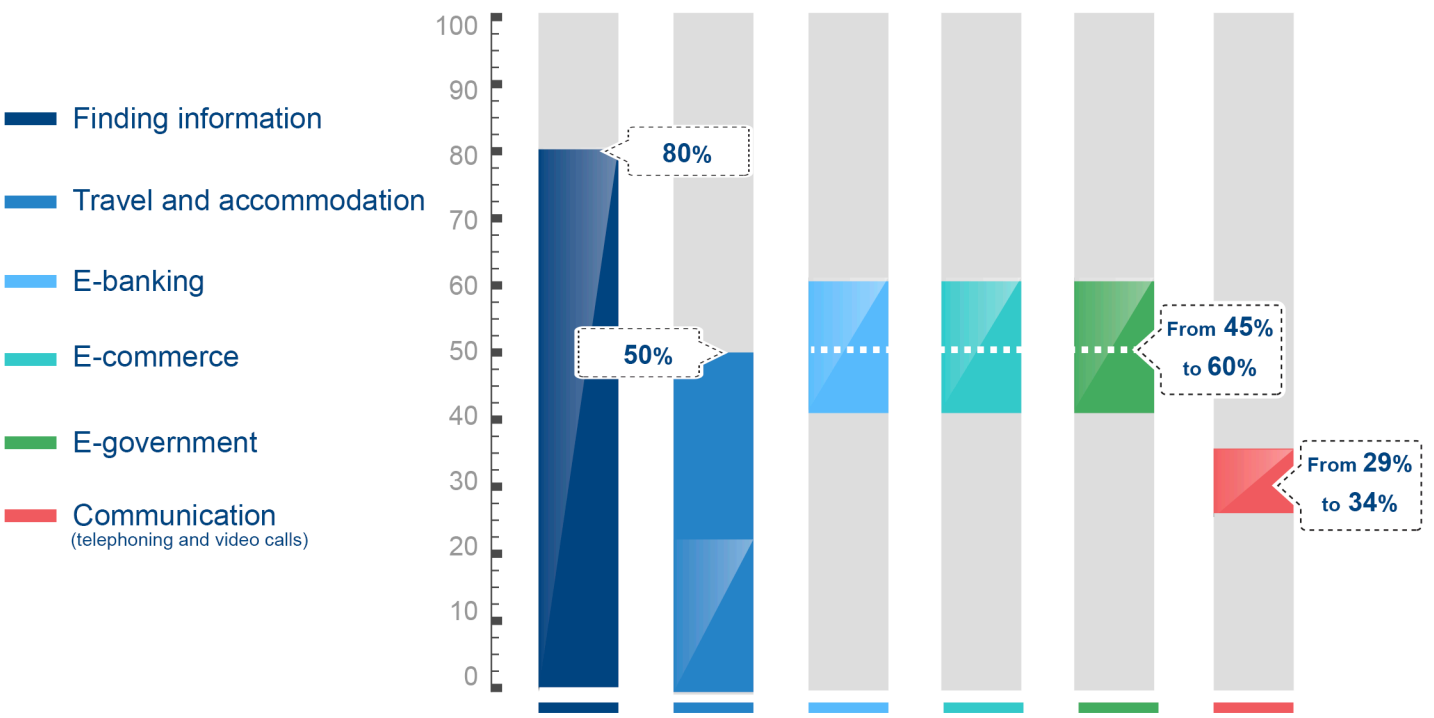


The growth is explained mainly because the proportion of people who use it on a daily basis has increased from 48.1% to 61.5%, while the rest of frequencies keep relatively constant.

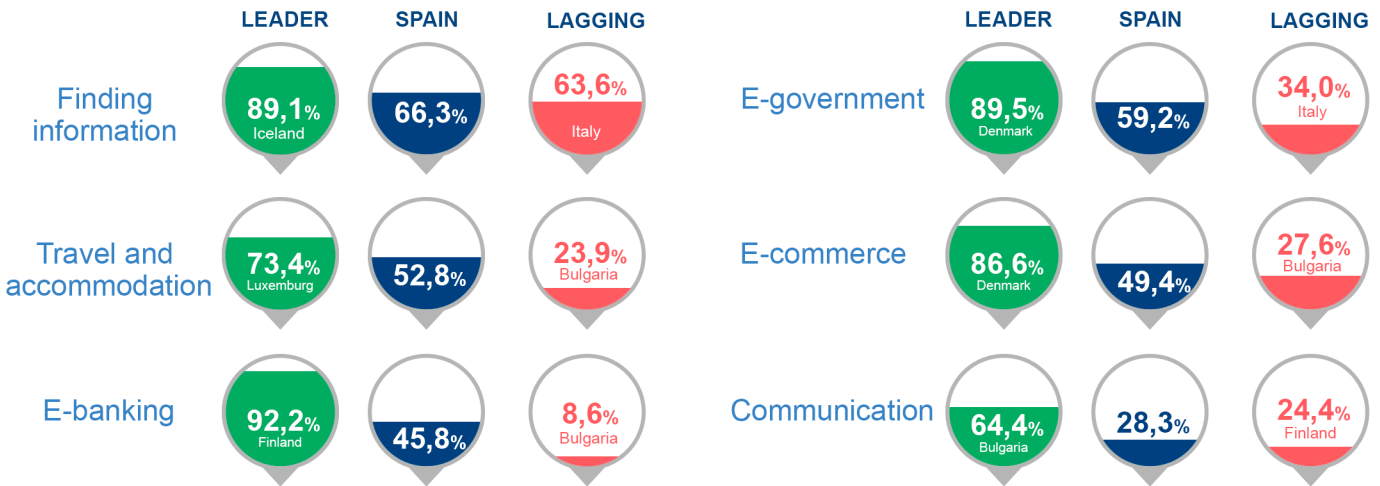
2. The difference among countries has fallen, but there are 3 groups:



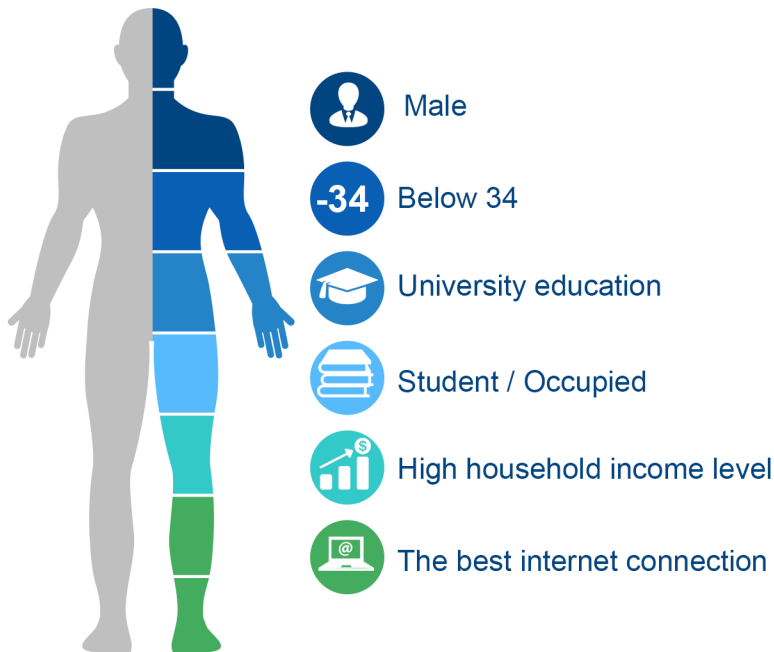
3. The process of adopting each activity in the Internet is at different stages between 2008 and 2013:

The regions including the capitals of **Spain, France, Greece and Hungary** show significant differences with respect to the other regions of the country. In the rest, there is a more homogenous use.
