Financial Regulation: Weekly Update. 4 November 2016

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GLOBAL

• IOSCO reports on implementation of G20/FSB measures to strengthen securities markets

Most jurisdictions have implemented measures regarding hedge funds, structured products, securitisation and CRA oversight. Work continues in the rest of the areas.

EUROPE

• EBA-ESMA consult on the assessment of the suitability of members of the management

Includes key function holders. The goal of the draft Guidelines is to foster and harmonise suitability assessments and guaranteeing sound governance. Deadline: 28 Jan.

• EBA reviews its guidelines on internal governance

The objective is to enhance the harmonisation of arrangements, processes and mechanisms according to the CRD IV and considering the proportionality principle. Deadline: 28 Jan.

• EBA publishes final guidelines on ICAAP and ILAAP information

The objective of the guidelines is to facilitate a consistent approach to the supervisory assessment of ICAAP and ILAAP frameworks throughout the EU as part of the SREP.

• EBA consults on Guidelines on authorisation under Payment Service Directive 2 (PSD2)

Guidelines specify the information that applicants must provide to get authorization as payment or electronic money institutions, and service providers for PSD2. Deadline: 3 Feb.

• FINMA redefines corporate governance guidelines for banks

The Swiss Financial Market Supervisory Authority (FINMA) has considered the most recent findings from the last crisis and the updated international standards. Entry into force: 1 Jul.

• EBA publishes final report on target level of national resolution financing arrangements

Recommends changing the basis from covered deposit to a total liabilities-based measure, particularly total liabilities (excluding own funds) less covered deposits.



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• EBA consults on new prudential regime for investment firms

In response to EC's call for technical advice on the design of a new prudential regime for investment firms. The aim is to develop a single set of simple requirements. Deadline: 2 Feb.

• OJEU publishes ITS on Solvency II

Implementing Technical Standard regarding templates for the submission of information to the supervisory authority. Entry into force 10 Nov.

• ECB publishes Guide on options and discretions (O&Ds)

Publishes final guide on O&Ds addressed to significant institutions and launches consultation on draft guidance on O&Ds addressed to less significant banks. Deadline: 5 Jan.

UNITED STATES

• CFTC further implements trade execution requirement

Further extends the time-limited no-action relief for swaps executed as part of a package transaction for a list of categories.
